The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 2079/7/18,1:00 at the office of Binayi Tribeni Rural Municipality Dumkibas, Nawalparasi (Bardaghat Susta East),. Bids must be valid for a period of 45 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security amounting to a minimum of 50000, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid. If bidder wishes to submit the Cash Security, the cash should be deposited in Deposit Account No. 00815153326, dharauti khata, Siddartha Baink, Dumkibas Branch and submit the receipt of the deposited amount of cash along with the Sealed Quotation.



Evaluation and Comparison of Quotations	21.1 In evaluating the Quotations, the Purchaser shall determine for each Sealed Quotation the evaluated Quotation Price by adjusting any corrections for errors. Quotations shall be checked by the Purchaser for any arithmetic errors. Errors shall be corrected by the Purchaser as follows:
